



The 2019 “Idle Hands” Red Wine, Columbia Valley

In a departure from previous years, the 2019 Idle Hands is comprised of equal parts Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. The blend showcases ample aromas of red and black fruits and crushed violets. The palate shows excellent weight, with brambly fruit flavors mingling with notes of vanilla and spice. The finish features ripe tannins and fresh acidity.

The 2019 Vintage

The 2019 growing season started out a bit sluggish, with cooler temperatures in Spring. By mid-summer, however, a long run of warm days across Eastern Washington through summer and early Fall made for another classic Washington vintage. The red wines from this vintage are notable for their freshness of fruit and buoyant acidity.
